Every staff member has their temperature checked and must answer questions	
regarding any signs and symptoms at the beginning of each shift.	
• All staff members are wearing masks while at work (and are encouraged to wear a mask	
while in public places –like the grocery store)	
• All essential vendors and consultants must have their temperature checked, answers	
questions regarding signs or symptoms, and wear a mask and gloves the entire time	
they are in the building.	
• Every resident has their temperature and oxygen saturation rate checked three-times	
per day.	
• There are no congregate activities in the building. Residents are taking their meals in	
their rooms and the Activities Department is proving in-room therapy.	
Residents are encouraged to maintain social distancing and visitation in another	
resident's room is not allowed.	
All staff members are following standard precautions and hand hygiene is strictly	
encouraged and enforced.	
The Environmental Services Department is cleaning surfaces with EPA approved	
chemicals rated to kill the COVID-19 virus.
