All residents and staff were tested Monday and today – there were no positive cases. Therefore we will reopen for visitation on Wednesday. The same process, as outlined below, will be in place. We are reopening visitation for all of our Residents under the same protocols as before:

- Visitation is from 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday – Sunday
- Visits must be scheduled through our Activities Department. **Please call 601-420-7762 to schedule your visit**
- Visits are for 30-minutes
- Visitors must wear a mask the entire time they are in the building
- Visitors must check-in at the security desk for temperature check and to answer questions regarding any signs or symptoms.
- After check-in, visitors must go directly to the resident’s room. Visitors are asked to use hand sanitizer prior to entering the room and to use hand sanitizer again before leaving the room.
- After your visit, you must immediately leave the building – do not go to the nurses’ station to ask questions. If you have questions or concerns, please call the facility.
