As you might have heard on the news, the Omicron variant of COVID is highly contagious. We have experienced 13 new cases in the past week among staff members – with new cases reported almost daily. <u>All of our residents are being tested weekly and so far, no resident</u> <u>has tested positive</u> – staff members are being tested twice per week. To protect our residents and visitors we are following all CMS and CDC guidelines.

You might have received information visitation is closed during this outbreak, that is not true – visitation is still completely open. However, we would ask that you limit your visitations where possible due to the nature of this variant. In addition, only two visitors are allowed in a resident's room at one time – additional visitors must rotate in and out of the room to maintain social distancing.
